March 17-23, 2019**

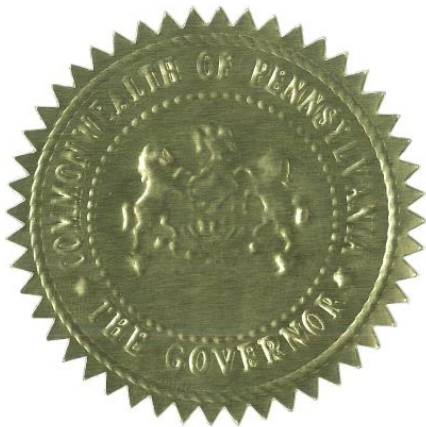
WHEREAS, land surveyors throughout history have played a crucial role in the mapping and design of the uncharted territories of our great nation; and
